Shri Sanjay Jha, Secretary General, Yoga Federation of India while extending welcome to all the members present in the meeting, conveyed his thanks to all of them for joining the meeting of YFI and requested Smt. Indu Aggarwal, President, YFI to preside over the meeting. The house unanimously consented and she gladly accepted the chair.

The President, YFI greeted the office bearers and Presidents & Secretaries of State Yoga Associations and conveyed thanks to the host, Yoga Sports Association of Andhra Pradesh, particularly to Shri CH. V. Narasimha Raju–Naresh, President, Shri CH. A.R.K. Varma, Working President, Shri M. Avinash Shetty, General Secretary, Yoga Sports Association of Andhra Pradesh & Shri V. S. Selvam, Organising Secretary of the Championship for making elaborate arrangements for the comfortable stay of the participating team from 27 states of India beside Yoga Team from All India Police Sports Control Board. She also conveyed her gratitude to Shri. Manohar Jala, Joint Secretary, YFI & General Secretary, Telangana Yoga Association for coordinating with the host to make this 46th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship possible at Tadepalligudem, West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh.

Before the meeting came into order, Shri CH. V. Narasimha Raju-Naresh, President. Yoga Sports Association of Andhra Pradesh extended hearty welcome to the office bearers, YFI and Presidents & Secretaries of State Yoga Associations. He promised to give all support to the Yoga Federation of India. Further he announced to honor the winners of the players of 46th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship with the cash award of Rs. 1000/-, Rs. 700/- & Rs. 500/- to the Gold, Silver & Bronze medal winner respectively. The house applauded his gesture.

The meeting came into order as per agenda of the meeting:-

i. Confirmation of the minutes of the previous Meeting of Yoga Federation of India.

It was informed by the President, YFI that for the last two years due to pandemic, no offline meeting of YFI was held. Although virtual meetings were held quite often to discuss regarding the online activities of Yoga Federation of India yet to discuss with the important ones, the Election Meeting of Yoga Federation of India was held on 19.01.2021 to elect the new house of YFI for the session 2021-25 in which the representation was given to almost all the affiliated units of YFI thus taking the number of office bearers to 49 members. Afterwards on the advice of the Senior Lawyer Shri Rahul Mehra, who is presenting the case of YFI in the Hon'ble Delhi High Court against the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, GOI as per National Sports Code of 2011 & 2017, it was decided by the house to reduce the number of office bearers to 12 members only and some amendments were also made in the constitution of YFI accordingly, which were approved in the meeting of YFI held on 11.03.2021.

Dr. Sher Singh, President, Yoga Sports Association of Rajasthan & Dr. Anita Patil, President, Maharashtra Yoga Association proposed, seconded by Shri G.N. Krishnamurthy, President, Karnataka State Amateur Yoga Sports Association & Shri Yash Parashar, General Secretary, Uttar Pradesh Yoga Association, and the house unanimously confirmed the minutes of the meetings of YFI held during the year 2021 & 2022.

ii. Annual report of Yoga Federation of India for the year 2020 & 2021.

Shri Sanjay Jha, Secretary General, YFI while presenting the Annual Report of Activities of Yoga Federation of India for the year 2020 & 2021 informed the house that inspite of Covid-19 situation, the Yoga Federation of India continued with its activities Live-Online by organizing 44th Sub-Junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship on 6th, 7th, 13th, 14th, 20th & 21st June, 2020, 45th Sub-Junior, Junior & Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship on 15th, 16th, 17th, 23rd, 24th, 30th & 31st January, 2021 & 46th Sub-Junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship on from 25th to 28th December 2021. Further the federation organized 4th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup Live-Online on 15th, 16th, 22nd, 23rd, 29th & 30th August, 2020 & 5th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup Live-Online on 10th, 11th, 17th, 18th, 24th & 25th July, 2021. The federation also conducted online National Yoga Referees Diploma Examination & Up-gradation Examination on 11th, October, 2020 & 14th, March, 2021. He further informed that 4th, 5th & 6th National Yoga Referee Refresher Courses were also organized during these two years to update the technical knowledge of National Yoga Referees of YFI as per revised rules & regulations of the National Yogasana Sports championship. He thanked the technical team of Yoga Federation of India specially Dr. Abhinav Joshi, Shri Harish Chitkara, Shri Arindam Mitra & Shri Amit, National Yoga Referees of YFI and also to all the Presidents & Secretaries of State Yoga Associations for their whole hearted support & co-operation for conducting online activities of YFI during these two years so smoothly & efficiently.

Yogiraj N. Ramalingam, General Secretary, Tamilnadu Yogasana Sports Association & Shri Jatin Solanki, General Secretary, Maharashtra Yoga Association and Dr. Rajiv Uppal, General Secretary, Chandigarh Yoga Association proposed and Shri Raman Kumar, Treasurer, YFI & General Secretary, Himachal Pradesh Yoga Association, Shri Ashish Kumar Pandey, Organising Secretary, Yoga Sports Association (Madhya Pradesh) and Shri Hari Prakash (AIPSCB) seconded and the house unanimously approved the report of Yoga Federation of India for the year 2021 & 2022.

iii. Allotment of 47th Sub Junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship, 47th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship & 6th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup.

The President, YFI requested Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal, Chairman, YFI to proceed further regarding future activities of YFI. While greeting the house with warm welcome, he informed that Shri Anirudh Gupta, President, Punjab Yoga Association has offered to host 47th Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship at Firozpur (Punjab) & assured to provide all facilities to the participants of the championship. Further he informed that Shri Rahul Vishwanath Karad, Executive President, MIT Group of Institutions, Pune who graced the inauguration ceremony of 46th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship on the request of Shri CH. V. Narasimha Raju–Naresh, President, Yoga Sports Association of Andhra Pradesh was kind enough to show his keenness to expand the yoga activities throughout the country and to organize a mega National event at MIT Pune. Therefore, it was proposed by Chairman, YFI to organize 47th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship at MIT Pune. He further informed the house that Dr. Abhinav Joshi, Executive Member, YFI & General Secretary, Yoga Sports Association of Rajasthan has shown his inclination to host 6th Federation Yogasana Sport Cup at Jaipur, Rajasthan.

Dr. Mohinder S. Kamboj, President, Chandigarh Yoga Association & Shri Shyamal Dutta (West Bengal) proposed, Shri Prabhat Chander Bora, Executive Member, YFI and General Secretary, Assam Yoga Association and Shri Paresh Bhatt, General Secretary, Gujarat Yoga Association seconded and the house unanimously allotted the 47th Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship to Punjab Yoga Association, 47th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship to Maharashtra Yoga Association to be hosted by MIT, Pune and 6th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup to Yoga Sports Association of Rajasthan to be hosted at Jaipur (Rajasthan). The Chairman, YFI informed that the exact dates of the said championships will be finalized after the meetings with the host Punjab Yoga Association & MIT, Pune very soon.

iv. Any other point to be discussed with the permission of chair.

(a) The President, YFI requested the Presidents & Secretaries of State Yoga Associations to upload the proceedings & major decision taken by their respective State Yoga Associations on the official portal of firms & societies to continue with the

registration of their respective State Yoga Associations with the firms & societies of their respective states. She further informed that the Yoga Federation of India has already uploaded the minutes & major decisions taken by the YFI on the official portal of firms & societies, Haryana since the year 1990, when the Yoga Federation of India was registered with The Registrar, Firms & Societies, Haryana, till date. She applauded the efforts of Shri Arindam Mitra, Organising Secretary, Haryana State Yoga Association for making all efforts in this regards.

(b) Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal, Chairman, YFI informed the house regarding the rule book of Yoga Federation of India written by Smt. Indu Aggarwal, President, YFI and designed & compiled by Dr. Abhinav Joshi, Executive Member, YFI, which was launched by YFI on 31st January, 2021 during the virtual prize distribution function of 45th Sub-junior, Junior & Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship. He further informed that the rule book is incorporated with all the rules, regulations & illustrated postures of National Yogasana Sports Championship, Federation Yogasana Sports Cup, National Yoga Referees Diploma Examination & other important information regarding conducting of various activities of Yoga Federation of India. He informed that the cost of the Rule Book is Rs. 250/- which will be deposited directly in the account of Yoga Federation of India as no royalty has been claimed by the writer or the designer of the rule book. He suggested all the members present in the meeting to encourage the National Yoga Referees & Players of their states to buy this book to get the complete information regarding all the latest rules & regulations of the National Yogasana Sports Championship & other activities of YFI.

As there was no other business to transact, the meeting came to end with vote of thanks to the chair.
