First of all Shri K. Prabhu, Executive Member, Yoga Federation of India, extended hearty welcome to the Office Bearers, Yoga Federation of India & the Presidents / Secretaries, State/UT Yoga Associations of Yoga Federation of India present in the meeting and requested Shri Sanjay Kumar Jha, Secretary General, Yoga Federation of India to request Smt. Indu Aggarwal, President, YFI to chair the meeting. Shri Sanjay Jha, Secretary General, Yoga Federation of India while extending welcome to all the Presidents / Secretaries, State / UT Yoga Associations and the office Bearers, Yoga Federation of India conveyed his thanks to all of them for joining the meeting and requested Smt. Indu Aggarwal, President, YFI to preside over the meeting, which was accepted by her. He also requested Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal, Life Time Chairman, Yoga Federation of India to motivate the members with his inspiring words.

Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal while welcoming all the members present in the meeting requested the President / Secretaries State / UT Yoga Association to cooperate with the activities of Yoga Federation of India with full enthusiasm so that YFI has all the documentation completed as per sports code of Government of India. He also requested all the Presidents / Secretaries State / UT Yoga Association to get the district bodies of their states registered with the societies registration act. He requested the President, YFI to continue with the proceedings as per agenda of the meeting.

The president, YFI while extending hearty welcome to all the members present in the meeting conveyed her thanks to the Officer Bearers, YFI and Presidents / Secretaries State / UT Yoga Associations for extending their whole hearted support to make the activities of Yoga Federation of India successful. She congratulated the State Presidents/ Secretaries for the celebration of 8th International Day of Yoga with all fervour especially to the State of Tamilnadu for exhibiting the performance of 10,000 Yoga enthusiasts from 38 Districts of Tamilnadu, a big show by the Yoga Association of Kerala of more than 700 yoga enthusiasts in the presence of high dignitaries of Kerala, a celebration by the States of Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Punjab, Chandigarh, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Gujarat & others. She requested the State Presidents/ Secretaries to share the videos / pictures of their activities for record of Yoga Federation of India.

Following points were discussed as per agenda of the meeting.

1. Mass Yogasana Demonstration at the occasion of 47th Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship to be held from October 08-11, 2022 at Dass and Brown World School, Ferozepur City (Punjab).

It was informed by the President, YFI that the Mass Yogasana Demonstration planned to be organized during 47th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship at MIT-Pune has been postponed for the time being on the request of the host MIT-Pune, as they need some more time to execute this program at the large scale. The new dates for the Mass Yogasana Demonstration will be informed as soon as the same will be confirmed by the host i.e. MIT-Pune.

For the time being the federation has planned to organize Mass Yogasana Demonstration during 47th Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship at Ferozepur City (Punjab) in which the players participating in the said National Yogasana Sports Championship from difference States / Union Territories of India will collectively perform the show. The protocol in this regards has already been shared by Yoga Federation of India to all the State / UT President / Secretaries. She requested all the President / Secretaries, State / UT to prepare their state winners who will be participating in the 47th Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship for the said Mass Yogasana Demonstration.

2. Organization of 47th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship by MIT-Pune (Maharashtra) and Maharashtra Yoga Association.

It was informed by the President, YFI that the All India Police Sports Control Board is planning to conduct the Volleyball Cluster (National Yoga Meet) from 10th to 15th December, 2022 at Punjab, therefore there is clash of dates i.e. December 07-11, 2022, fixed for 47th Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship. The federation is trying to contact AIPSCB to re-schedule their program of Volleyball Cluster, if possible, otherwise after consulting the host MIT-Pune, the next dates will be planned and accordingly informed to all concerned.

3. Organization of 6th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup.

The President, YFI, requested the members present in the meeting to decide whether the 6th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup pending for the session 2021-22 should be organized online or offline. She also requested Shri V. Dassaradan, Gen. Sec., Pondicherry Yoga & Yoga Sports Development Association to confirm whether their association is ready to host the said Federation Yogasana Sports Cup at Puducherry. Shri V. Dassaradan shown his inability to host 6th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup due to shortage of time but assured the house to organize 7th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup of the session 2022-23 in the month of May 2023 at Puducherry, which was cheerfully accepted by the house.

Dr. Abhinav Joshi, Gen. Sec., Yoga Sports Association of Rajasthan offered to host the 6th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup in Rajasthan. After brief discussion it was approved by the members present in the meeting that the 6th Federation Yogasana Sports Cup will be likely to be held in the month of August, 2022 at Jaipur (Rajasthan). The exact dates & venue will be intimated shortly after hearing from the host i.e. Yoga Sports Association of Rajasthan.

4. Regarding holding of State Yogasana Sports Championships.

It was requested by the President, YFI that all the State / UT Yoga Associations must conduct their State / UT Yogasana Sports Championship by the month of August, 2022 and inform the dates to the Yoga Federation of India, as the last date of entry for 47th Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship is 01st September, 2022. Moreover the State winners are also to be prepared for Mass Yogasana Demonstration at Ferozepur (Punjab) during 47th Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship as per protocol already shared with the State Presidents / Secretaries.

5. Registration of State Yoga Players.

The Federation has repeatedly requested the State Presidents / Secretaries to get their player registered with the YFI. Once again it was requested by President, YFI that as soon as the State / UT Yogasana Sports Championship is concluded immediately the data for registration of players must be sent to the YFI as per Google Forms Link (https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAlpQLSe6DWI-0UG_b6eOSjSj_gjcli2aNkc4OqluDQ9A1MH1hW4JRg/viewform)

alongwith the player registration fee of Rs. 50/- per player (only this year), so that their data can be uploaded on the website of YFI and their I-Card can be prepared in time. Nobody will be allowed to participate in the ensuing Nationals without Player Registration Card.

6. Registration of State / District Yoga Associations with Societies Registration Act.

The Yoga Federation of India had requested all the State Presidents / Secretaries to get their District Yoga Associations registered with the Societies Registration Act, give them affiliation and inform the federation by 20th June, 2022 but so far the federation has received the updating from only three states i.e. Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka & Haryana. The President, YFI again requested all the members present in the meeting to get at least 50% district bodies out of the total districts of their states to get registered, affiliated and inform the federation by 15th July, 2022.

7. Any other point to be discussed with the permission of chair.

(i) Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal, Chairman, Yoga Federation of India requested the house that the State / District Presidents / Secretaries must follow the rules of Yoga Federation of India earlier decided regarding entry, affiliation, referee examination fee as below:

(ii) Dr. M.S. Kamboj, President, Chandigarh Yoga Association suggested that like other chain groups, the Yoga Federation of India must have a particular design / colour of the banners to be displayed during National / State / District Yogasana Sports Championship or any other such activities, so that there is uniformity in all the activities of Yoga Federation of India as well as its affiliated units, which was appreciated by the house. It was further requested that designing for that may be prepared voluntarily by any of the members of Yoga Federation of India.

As there was no other business to transact, the meeting came to end with vote of thanks to the chair.
