First of all Shri Yash Parashar, Joint Secretary, Yoga Federation of India, extended hearty welcome to the Office Bearers, Yoga Federation of India & the Presidents / Secretaries, State/UT Yoga Associations of Yoga Federation of India present in the meeting and requested Shri Sanjay Kumar Jha, Secretary General, Yoga Federation of India to request Smt. Indu Aggarwal, President, YFI to chair the meeting. Shri Sanjay Jha, Secretary General, Yoga Federation of India while extending welcome to all the Presidents/Secretaries, State / UT Yoga Associations and the office Bearers, Yoga Federation of India conveyed his thanks to all of them for joining the meeting of YFI and requested Smt. Indu Aggarwal, President, YFI to preside over the meeting, which was gladly accepted by her.

The president, YFI while extending hearty welcome and thanks to all the members present in the meeting informed the house that this meeting has been convened to have the view of the Presidents/Secretaries, State/UT Yoga Associations as to whether the 46<sup>th</sup> Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship scheduled to be held from 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 at Tadepalligudem West Godavari District (Andhra Pradesh) may be organized offline or online. Further she informed that the federation had received the entry proforma of three states only i.e. West Bengal, Punjab & Haryana by the last date of entry i.e. 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2022. She requested Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal, Life Time Chairman, Yoga Federation of India to proceed further in this regards.

Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal, Chairman, YFI, extended warm welcome to the members present in the meeting and expressed his gratitude to the Presidents / Secretaries, State Yoga Associations & National Yoga Referees of Yoga Federation of India for their support and cooperation and also to Shri Arindam Mitra, Organizing Secretary, Haryana State Yoga Association and his team member Shri Amit for their technical support for successfully organizing virtual 46<sup>th</sup> Sub-junior & Junior National Yogasana Sports Championship from 25<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 and virtual 6<sup>th</sup> National Yoga Referees' Refresher Course on 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2022.

Regarding organization of 46<sup>th</sup> Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship offline/online, he requested all the State Presidents and Secretaries to express their views. After getting suggestions from all the members present in the meeting, it was noted that Presidents / Secretaries of 21 State / UT Yoga Associations namely :- Maharashtra, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Chandigarh, Haryana, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Assam, Punjab, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Gujarat, Delhi, Manipur & Nagaland gave their consent for offline 46<sup>th</sup> Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship.

Shri CH. A.R.K. Varma, Working President. Yoga Sports Association of Andhra Pradesh while extending his gratitude to all the members for giving their consent for offline 46<sup>th</sup> Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship assured the house for all facilities to be provided by Yoga Association of Andhra Pradesh during the said championship at Tadepalligudem West Godavari District (Andhra Pradesh). He suggested the said championship to be organized from 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 at the same venue, which was approved by all the members present in the meeting. Shri Ashok Kumar Aggarwal requested the state Presidents/Secretaries to send the entry proforma / entry fee by 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 positively and informed that after which the late fee of Rs. 200/- per competitor i.e. Rs. 500/- per competitor will be charged by the Federation.

Shri Sanjay Jha, Secretary General, YFI informed the house that in the meeting of Board of Directors of Yogasana Premier League held on 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2022, it was decided by the members that due to involvement of the YFI in the court case the Yoga Federation of India and Asian Yoga Federation has withdrawn its support to the Jaipur Yoga League for organizing Yogasana Premier League and requested all the Presidents / Secretaries, State / UT Yoga Associations to inform the National Yoga Referees & Players of Yoga Federation of India of their respective States / UTs not to use the name / logo of Yoga Federation of India / Asian Yoga Federation for their participation in the Yogasana Premier League.

Smt. Indu Aggarwal requested the State Secretaries to send the details of new players for registration in the excel sheet as per format shared earlier, by 20<sup>th</sup> February 2022 positively, so that their data can be uploaded in the website of Yoga Federation of India and also the Identity Card of players can be prepared in advance so that when the players come for participation in the National Yogasana Sports Championship, they must have player registration card with them. Further she informed that so far the data of junior players for player registration has been received from the states of Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Odisha, Punjab & Uttar Pradesh and Junior and Senior Players from Maharashtra and Assam States only. She further requested all the Presidents / Secretaries State Yoga Associations to send the information regarding the National Yoga Referees going to attend the said championship preferably those who have attended the National Yoga Referee Refresher Courses / Workshops conducted by Yoga Federation of India and also all the information as per entry proforma by 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 positively so that the information can be sent to the host timely for necessary arrangements to be made by them.

She also conveyed her gratitude to Shri CH. A.R.K. Varma, Working President, Shri M. Avinash Shetty, General Secretary and President & Officer Bearers of Yoga Sports Association of Andhra Pradesh for shouldering the responsibility to host the 46<sup>th</sup> Senior National Yogasana Sports Championship from 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 at Tadepalligudem West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh. She also conveyed her thanks to Shri Manohar Jala, Joint Secretary, Yoga Federation of India for coordinating with the host, Yoga Sports Association of Andhra Pradesh for conducting the said national in the state of Andhra Pradesh and assured them for all co-operations from Yoga Federation of India for the successful organization of the said championship.

The President, YFI conveyed the house regarding the resignation rendered by Dr. Abhinav Joshi, Executive Member, YFI. Keeping in view his contribution to YFI, the house refused to accept his resignation & requested him to continue with the Yoga Federation of India.

As there was no other business to transact, the meeting came to end with vote of thanks to the chair.
